Council notes the following advice of the Corporate Governance Committee regarding financial sustainability for consideration in finalising the 2023/24 Draft Annual Business Plan and Draft Long Term Financial Plan.

- Supports option 1 (rate rise 7.91%) due to the following reasons;
 - Promotes financial sustainability by bringing Council in line with its target ratios
 - Allows for the continuation of existing services as well new services and projects
 - Rate increase in line with CPI is prudent financial management and avoids rate increases in excess of CPI in future years
 - Proposed budget includes continuous improvement savings to help fund part of the budget
 - Proposed budget manages the risk associated with significant growth by providing additional resourcing
 - Preparation of the budget has been well considered and reasoned, and is comprehensive in terms of the challenges facing Council
