- Council's response text to be differentiated from the Auditor-General's report text which may include a summary table detailing each recommendation from the Auditor-General report and the Council response;
- Clarify the reasons and timeframes for employee costs detailed in the management response and include reference to the Auditor-General's scope letter:
- Include comment that the Auditor-General's report failed to conclude on what was the defined objective of the audit;
- Reword the management response to Recommendation 14: Council considers the Auditor – General's Recommendation as a general opinion, as Council has a policy in place that allows for such functions; however due to the sensitivities of the item, Council notes the Auditor General's opinion and will review the Elected Member Support Policy and associated Guidelines; and
- Authorise the Chief Executive Officer to make minor amendments without changing the intent of the management response.
