  - Reword the management response to Recommendation 14: Council considers the Auditor – General's Recommendation as a general opinion, as Council has a policy in place that allows for such functions; however due to the sensitivities of the item, Council notes the Auditor General's opinion and will review the Elected Member Support Policy and associated Guidelines; and
  - Authorise the Chief Executive Officer to make minor amendments without changing the intent of the management response.
- 2) That the Council resolve that following the Auditor-General's report being tabled in State Parliament:
  - 1. Council make available via the Council website expense transaction reports relating to Corporate credit cards for the period commencing 1 January 2020 in the manner and form determined by the Chief Executive Officer.
