Council, and developers who hand trees to Council as part of new developments, do plant native trees with approximately 62% of tree plantings being native and 38% being non-native over the past 3 years.

Our preference is to plant natives, however, non-natives are planted to increase tree diversity and ensure the right tree is planted in the right location.
