8.1 Sian Bisschop – Grenville Hub

- Grenville Hub building has been demolished
- Now operating in the Playford Civic Centre Function rooms
- The Grenville Hub has been operating for 35 years
- There is a wide range of groups using the centre
- Groups operating within the centre are;
 - o Fitness, Table Tennis, line dancing
 - o Lifestyle programs.
 - o There are 300 volunteers and Home Assist programs
 - o Living Life work their own program
- Meals available 5 days a week
- Frozen meals are available along with take away.
- The kitchen has a 5 star rating
- People have received employment achieved from their volunteer work
- Community home support, My Aged Care.
- There are shows on a regular basis.

- South Australia Housing Authority is now stand alone
- Business as usual
- Looked at what we do and how to manage tenants
 - o Anti-social behaviour, impact on neighbours,
- Reviewed how to cope with complaints

- Stronger, swifter approach for serious complaints

• Pauline

- At Thompson Beach the migrating multi banded shorebird **GREAT KNOT**, was sighted on 25th March 2019
- This particular bird was sighted and banded in Broom Western Australia September 2010 again in 2011. Not seen for a few years till again in Broom January 2016, also sighted in China near North Korean border in May 2016, then in Russia July 2016 and 27th June 2018. This visitation has caused excitement amongst Australia's birders
- This bird travels 10,000 kms on its migratory flight annually
- Getting ready to distribute plants for Buffers to Bushland in City of Playford nursery
- Tabled "Attracting Native wildlife to your garden" bookings essential
