 - This covers a wide area e.g.: Playford, Tea Tree Gully, Port Adelaide Enfield, Salisbury, Light, Gawler, Adelaide Plains and Barossa Councils
- Interstate visitors have been very impressed by the Stretton Centre model co-working with a number of organisations
- One of the co-working businesses works with injured workers to help achieve a successful recovery and return to work.
- Promote businesses
- Mentoring programs
- 3D printing may come on line
- Stretton works with local business and the City of Playford planning team to help progress planning approval and work through planning approval issues.

- Jobs for the future funded by the Premier
