## **RSA Update**

### Mick Bozo from Renewal SA

Project Progress to Date:

- More than 330 homes renovated and 186 new public housing dwellings constructed
- Playford Town Centre with Woolworths and specialty retail stores open
- Diverse mix of new facilities available along Curtis Rd (childcare, medical, veterinary, gyms, food retail, fuel outlet, post office etc). All Curtis Rd North lots sold or under contract.
- 3 new schools open
- Creation of Town Park, two wetlands and other open space
- Opening of 2<sup>nd</sup> display village
- More than 2,750 people have taken part in The Works Program @ Playford Alive with 922 paid employment outcomes
- Provision of more than \$745k from PAIF for community grants plus capital funds to enable the Stretton Centre and John McVeity redevelopment
- 6 local heroes awards and seven (7) Playford Alive Community Fun Days held.
- Partnership with Habitat for Humanity to deliver new affordable homes for private ownership

Status of 2017/18 Key Deliverables

- Lot delivery underway in Munno Para and Davoren Park
- 30 public housing dwellings under construction
- Works program delivered this year 58 work experience, 25 paid employment, 51 training places and 3 live training sites
- New marketing program underway Why Wait Digital Series
