FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

THIS EVENT IS OPERATING UNDER AN APPROVED COVID MANAGEMENT PLAN AND IS SUBJECT TO THE DIRECTIONS AT THE TIME OF THE EVENT.

How much does it cost to come to the ANZAC Day Dawn Service?

The event is free.

Do I need to book tickets?

No, the event is not ticketed however, audience controls will apply.

What is the maximum capacity for this event?

The event site will be fully fenced and have a maximum capacity of 2,500. Once this capacity has been reached, no further attendees will be allowed into the event.

Are pass outs allowed for this event?

No pass outs are available at this event due to audience controls so please bring everything you need with you.

How do I get to the event?

The event site is located at Smithfield Memorial Gardens. Many public transport options, including bus, go to and from the site – please see Adelaide Metro website for routes and times. There is ample free parking surrounding the venue and the Smithfield Hotel is a short walk to the gardens. Please read the parking signage though to avoid a potential fine.

What do I need to bring?

You can travel light and just bring yourself or you are welcome to bring the following items -

- Weather protection – rain jacket, scarf, beanie etc.
- Your smartphone/camera

What is not allowed?

Please do not bring chairs, picnic blankets, umbrellas, animals, glass or alcohol to the event.

What if it rains?

This event is a 100% outdoor, open-air event. If weather conditions become extreme, we will enact our inclement weather policy to determine if the event is to be relocated indoors, postponed or cancelled.

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What is the seating like?

There are 3 seating options available:

- **Tiered seating** – The tiered seating will have a capacity of 75%. A COVID Marshal will assist you where to sit
- **Lawned areas** – Seating will be available in front of the Cenotaph. Volunteers can assist you with where to sit
- **Standing area** – Standing room will be available behind the Cenotaph. This area will be managed by COVID Marshals to ensure social distancing is observed between groups

What time do the gates open?

The gates will open at 4.30am with the formalities commencing at approximately 6.00am. Please ensure you allow enough time to arrive, park and complete contact tracing.

Where do I enter the venue?

The main entry is via Anderson Walk, and a second entrance located at the north-west end of the gardens (Morialta Drive).

What can I expect when entering the event?

There will be two entry points to the event – **Anderson Walk and at the north-west end of the gardens (Morialta Drive)**. There may be queues to enter the event - if queues do form, there will be COVID Marshals managing the queues to ensure social distancing between groups.

Every person who enters the event site will need to complete the South Australian Government's COVID SAfe Check-In, accessed via QR code on arrival. In order to scan the QR code, you can use the [mySA Gov](https://mySA.gov.au) app or the camera on your smartphone. If you do not have a smartphone, there will be paper contact tracing forms available.

I am attending as a part of a group, do we all need to arrive at the same time?

Yes, it would be ideal if you arrive together with your whole family / social group, to ensure that you can all sit together.

Will there be any food or drink available?

No, there will not be any food or drink available at this event. Breakfast is available for purchase by the Smithfield Sports and Social Club after the service concludes.

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What if the event is cancelled?

Any decision to cancel the event will be made by the General Manager – Strategy & Corporate, Senior Manager – Community Engagement & Experience, Mayor and Presiding Member – Civic Events Committee in consultation with the Event Manager. Upon cancellation, the Event Organisers will (where required and appropriate):

- Provide advice of the cancellation on the City of Playford website and
- Communicate through other available channels where practicable i.e. email and Facebook
