Council may grant permits	1.1 The power pursuant to Clause 5.1 of the Permits and Penalties By-law 2022 (the Permits By-law) to, where a by-law of the Council indicates that a person needs a permit or permission of the Council to do a specified thing, grant a permit, in writing. 1. Council may grant permits	1.2 The power pursuant to Clause 5.3 of the Permits By-law to: 1.2.1 provide that the permit applies for a particular term; 1.2.2 attach conditions to a permit the delegate thinks are appropriate; 1.2.3 change or revoke a condition, by notice in writing; or 1.2.4 add new conditions, by notice in writing. 1. Council may grant permits	1.3 The power pursuant to Clause 5.5 of the Permits By-law to revoke a permit, by notice in writing, if: 1.3.1 the holder of the permit fails to comply with a condition attached to it; or 1.3.2 the permit is of a continuing nature, and the Delegate has reasonable grounds for revoking it. Activities requiring permission	2.1 Access to Waters  2.1.1 The power pursuant to Clause 4.1 of the Land By-law to erect a sign on local government land stating that entering any waters or swimming or using a boat in or on waters in an area on local government land is permitted in accordance with any condition stated in the sign. 2. Activities requiring permission	2.2 Animals on Local Government Land  2.2.1 The power pursuant to Clause 4.6 of the Land By-law to set aside a track or car park on local government land other than the foreshore for use by or in connection with any livestock.	Chief Executive Officer	
2. Activities requiring permission	2.3 Camping  2.3.1 The power pursuant to Clause 4.13 of the Land By-law to erect a sign on local government land indicating that camping on the land is permitted.	Chief Executive Officer

1. Identification of cats	1.1 The power pursuant to Clause 4.3 of the Cats By-law 2022 ('the Cats By-law') to grant an extension of time within which to comply or exempt the owner of a cat from the identification of cats set by Clause 4 of the Cats By-law.	Chief Executive Officer	
2. Limit on cat numbers	2.1 The power pursuant to Clause 5.2 of the Cats By-law to determine that 2.1.1 no insanitary condition exists on a premises as a result of the keeping of cats; 2.1.2 a nuisance is not caused to any neighbour as a result of the keeping of cats on a premises; and 2.1.3 all cats kept on a premises are desexed and microchipped in accordance with any requirements of the Dog and Cat Management Act 1995	Chief Executive Officer

Notice	1.1 The power pursuant to Clause 6.1 of the Bird Scaring Devices By-law 2022 (the Bird By-law) to, where there is a breach of any provision of the Bird By-law, serve notice in writing on the owner or occupier of any land upon which a device is being used or employed requiring that person to reduce the number of activations of a device or to disarm or to remove a device. 1. Notice	1.2 The power pursuant to Clause 6.3 of the Bird By-law to, if the notice is not complied with, carry out or cause to be carried out the measures required by the notice and recover the cost of so doing from the person to whom the notice was directed.	Chief Executive Officer

1. Activities requiring permission	<p>1.2 Bicycles</p> <p>The power pursuant to Clause 4.4 of the Roads By-law to set aside a structure for the purpose of chaining, locking or affixing a bicycle.</p>	Chief Executive Officer	
1. Activities requiring permission	<p>1.3 Camping</p> <p>The power pursuant to Clause 4.6 of the Roads By-law to determine a road on which camping or sleeping overnight in a motorhome is permitted and to erect a sign or signs indicating that camping on the road in such a vehicle is permitted.</p>	Chief Executive Officer
