



Application for a Permit to Keep Additional Animals

The City of Playford regulates the keeping of cats and dogs under Section 249(4) of the *Local Government Act 1999*; **By Law No.4 – Dogs** and **By Law No. 5 – Cats**.

By limiting the number of dogs and cats that can be kept on premises, Council is able to provide for the control and management of dogs and cats in the Council’s area. A \$40.50 application fee applies.

You will need a permit if you: Keep more than 2 dogs AND/OR Keep more than 2 domestic cats

Returning documents to Council

For your convenience, Council offers a number of ways for you to return documents:

- Hand delivering by visiting one of Council's Customer Care points

What happens next?

- Once your application has been received by Council, your application will be assigned for assessment and you will be contacted by the Regulatory Services team.
- An inspection of the property where the animals are to be kept may be required. Inspectors are looking at the cleanliness of the property, the ability to keep the animals contained, that animals will be properly cared for and will not cause a nuisance to neighbours.
- Once the permit is approved, the permit fee of **\$40.50** is payable to Council.
- Payment can be made over the phone, or by visiting one of Council's Customer Care points.
- Upon making payment, the permit will be processed and you will be provided with a copy of the permit for you to sign agreeing to the conditions and keep for your records.
- If approved, the permit will only be for the animals listed.
- Any complaints in the future that are substantiated, may result in enforcement action that can include revocation of the permit and the requirement to reduce the number of dogs or cats at the property.
