What is Community Signage?

Community Facility Signs are blue directional signs with white text that can be erected by Council to indicate businesses or not-for-profit community facilities.

How much does Community Signage cost?

The cost of works and manufacture of the signs is priced as denoted in the City of Playford's [Schedule of Fees and Charges](#).

Community facilities of a commercial nature identified on the sign will be responsible for the cost of installation, maintenance and any ongoing upgrades and alterations.

Community facility signs for not-for-profit organisations will be installed, maintained and removed by the City of Playford at no charge to the community facility.



What can I put on a Community Sign?

The wording on a Community Sign must be limited to a maximum of 10 characters per line with a total of 20 characters per sign. Signs for community facilities of non-for-profit organisations shall only include a generic description and not the facility name (ie, Scout Hall, Recreation Centre, Community Centre, etc)
