SUMMARY

Signage includes any form of advertising, mural or other display. In most circumstances, signs require [Development Approval](#). Please contact the Council directly if you wish to erect a sign, to ensure you have the required approval in place.

REQUIREMENTS FOR BUILDING RULES CONSENT

Many forms of signage within the City of Playford require Development Plan Consent. Please contact the Planning Department to confirm whether Planning Consent and Development Approval is required for your sign.

When a sign requires Building Rules Consent, certain structural elements must be checked. The requirements for Building Rules Consent may require the inclusion of a Structural Engineering Report. This, in addition to further information that may be required, will be determined once you submit your application for Building Rules Consent.

Once you receive your Building Rules Consent and Development Approval you must refer to the Council notification stages outlined in your approval. Refer to the 'Notification Fact Sheet' for further information on notification stages.
