

CITY OF PLAYFORD ENVIRONMENTAL CONCERNS



Council often receives enquires from members of the public to find out to who is responsible for issues such as noise, dust, waste, mud, water pollution, security fences and boundary encroachments. Whilst some activities on construction sites are noisy or may generate dust and mud, some of these may often be controlled using improved work practices.

During the construction of any large development the contractor is ultimately responsible for managing all such matters. Firstly, we would suggest contacting the Site Manager or Agent. Their name and contact number should be clearly displayed at the main entrance to the site.
