

IMMUNISATION INFORMATION FOR PREGNANT WOMEN



Whooping cough (pertussis) and influenza (flu) vaccines are very safe to be given during pregnancy and are recommended to protect both mother and baby during pregnancy and in the first few months after birth.

Both vaccinations are free for pregnant women. The pertussis vaccination is recommended for women in the third trimester of pregnancy.
