

Immunisation is a simple, safe and effective way of protecting people against harmful diseases that can cause serious health problems in the community. The more people who are vaccinated, the fewer opportunities a disease has to spread.

We provide routine childhood vaccinations against diseases that were once widely fatal, such as measles, diphtheria and whooping cough, as well as more recently developed vaccines, such as Human Papillomavirus (HPV) and the meningococcal C vaccine. The flu vaccination is also now available at our public clinics.

Free vaccinations are available if they are listed in the National Immunisation Programs SA Schedule. Costs do apply to those vaccines that are not listed in this schedule.
