

# The Playford Community Vision 2043 is an articulation of the communities' collective values and vision for how Playford will look and feel in 30 years.

The Vision is aspirational in nature and has primarily been developed through identified key priorities voiced by the community and stakeholders during a comprehensive information gathering exercise.

It has also been developed in reference to key State Government and Council strategic policies and documents, including the Plans for Greater Adelaide, the State Strategic Plan, SA Government Seven Strategic Priorities and the State Infrastructure Plan.

Key themes of prosperity, liveability and happiness were identified as the means to achieving the Vision of Playford being the City of Opportunity.

A diversity of lifestyle choices will be on offer, based on being connected, well-planned and attractive with the appropriate infrastructure and services to support a village type atmosphere for both urban and rural living.

- Safe communities




## **Happiness**
