What? Competition play for Juniors (Under 8s - Under 14s), and Senior Men. SACBA will also be offering coaching development if anyone is interested in trying their hand at coaching basketball, as well as referee training and development for our competition.

Ages? Juniors: Under 8's – Under 16's, Seniors: 16+/open age competition.

Game Times? Juniors: Tuesday afternoons | 4:15-6pm (during school term only)

Seniors: Tuesday evenings | 6pm – 8pm.

Season Dates? Juniors: Term 4 (25th October to 13th December)

Seniors: October 25th to April 4th | Break for Holidays December - January

Cost? Team Registration Fee: Free for Inaugural Season

Player Registration Fee: \$24.18 (365 Day Membership)

Weekly Team Fee: \$65

Experience required? No, both beginner and experienced players are welcome.
