The City of Playford is pleased to inform you that kerb renewal works on STOCKTON STREET, ELIZABETH are about to commence as part of Council's Capital Works Program. This work involves the renewal kerb, as well as the upgrade of kerb ramps for accessibility compliance. Kerb-Tec have been contracted by Council to complete this work.

WHEN WILL WORK START?

Work in your street will commence on 08/12/2025 and is expected to be completed on 18/02/2026 the Wet weather may delay the scheduling of these works.

HOW WILL THIS AFFECT ME?

At times, construction works may impact your ability to access your driveway / residence. Kerb-Tec will work with residents to ensure there is as little inconvenience as possible. Traffic control signs and speed restrictions will be in place to ensure the safety of pedestrians and motorists.

If there is any work that involves the section of your kerb invert that crosses over your driveway, Kerb-Tec will excavate your driveway kerb invert and may temporarily fill this with quarry materials until the kerb invert is reinstated.
