



NOTICE TO RESIDENTS

FOOTPATH WORKS YORKTOWN ROAD, ELIZABETH PARK

The City of Playford is pleased to inform you that footpath renewal works on Yorktown Road, Elizabeth Park are about to commence as part of Council's Capital Works Program. This work involves the renewal and widening of the existing footpath, as well as the upgrade of kerb ramps for accessibility compliance. Parisi Paving have been contracted by Council to complete this works.

When will work start?

Work in your street will commence on 20 / 10 / 25 and is expected to be completed on the 19 / 12 / 25. Wet weather may delay the scheduling of these works.

How will this affect me?

Footpaths may also be closed to pedestrians during construction but will be reopened once completed. Parisi Paving will work with residents to ensure there is as little inconvenience as possible.

Parisi Paving will also work with the waste collection contractor to ensure rubbish bins are accessible and collected on your regular collection days. Our crew will assist in relocating bins to a suitable pick-up location and returning them afterward.

Can we please ask that all vehicles are not parked on verges or footpaths during the construction period. This will help ensure the safety of workers and allow for works to proceed without delay.

Traffic control signs and speed restrictions will be in place to ensure the safety of pedestrians and motorists.
