



NOTICE TO RESIDENTS



KERB RENEWAL WORKS – BROOKER DRIVE, HILLBANK

The City of Playford is pleased to inform you that kerb maintenance works on will soon be undertaken on Brooker Drive, Hillbank as part of Council's Capital Works Program.

The works will involve the repair and replacement of sections of damaged kerbing and associated concrete infrastructure to maintain the safety and functionality of Council assets. Council has engaged **Parisi Paving** to undertake these works on its behalf.

When will work start?

Works are scheduled to commence on **1st July 2026** and are expected to be completed by **17 July 2026**, weather permitting.

Please note that inclement weather or unforeseen site conditions may impact the construction program and result in delays.

How will this affect me?

During construction, temporary restrictions to vehicle access may apply, particularly while newly poured concrete is curing. Concrete generally requires approximately 24 hours before vehicle access can be reinstated.

Footpaths within the work area may also be temporarily closed; however, pedestrian access will be reinstated as soon as it is safe to do so.

Parisi Paving will contact directly affected residents prior to works commencing to discuss any vehicle access requirements and make suitable arrangements where possible. Every effort will be made to minimise inconvenience to residents throughout the construction period.

Council and the contractor will also coordinate with waste collection services to ensure bins remain accessible for collection on their normal collection days. Where required, construction crews will assist by relocating bins to an appropriate collection point and returning them following collection.

To assist with the safe and efficient completion of the works, residents are requested not to park vehicles adjacent to the kerb, on verges, or on footpaths within the work area during the construction period.

Traffic management measures, including temporary signage and reduced speed limits, will be in place to ensure the safety of workers, residents, pedestrians, and motorists.
