



NOTICE TO RESIDENTS

KERB RAMP RENEWAL WORKS

The Glade/ President Avenue, Andrews Farm

The City of Playford is pleased to advise that the construction of Disability Discrimination Act (DDA) compliant kerb ramps will be undertaken at the intersection of The Glade and President Avenue, Andrews Farm. These works form part of Council's ongoing DDA accessibility improvement program.

The project involves the renewal of two kerb ramps on The Glade, including the construction of compliant footpath landings where required. The new kerb ramps will be reinstated on the existing tangent points where possible and tie into the existing footpath network.

Parisi Paving have been contracted by Council to complete this works.

When will work start?

Works are scheduled to commence on **17 June 2026** and are expected to be completed by **24 June 2026**, weather permitting. Inclement weather may impact the construction schedule.

How will this affect me?

During construction, footpaths within the work area may be temporarily closed to pedestrians. Access will be reinstated as soon as the works are completed. Parisi Paving will work closely with residents to minimise inconvenience wherever possible.

Council will coordinate with the waste collection contractor to ensure rubbish bins remain accessible and are collected on their usual collection days. Construction crews will assist by relocating bins to a suitable collection point and returning them following collection.

Residents are kindly requested not to park vehicles on footpaths or verges during the construction period. This will help maintain a safe work environment and allow the works to proceed efficiently.

Traffic management measures, including signage and temporary speed restrictions, will be in place throughout the construction period to ensure the safety of pedestrians, motorists, and workers.
